Quarter 4 Highlights

Spring semester 2017 brought depth of study for many NorthStar students. The students who participated in the Worldviews course dove into understanding how post-modern culture's ideologies and ways of thinking, though they are not labeled as faith systems, are belief systems because they guide one's actions and behaviors. Belief can be based on what one believes is true or what one believes is not true. And navigating what one believes is challenging in a culture that presents theories and philosophies as facts and supports that one can live a good moral life without absolute truth as a guide.

In the Genesis & Biology course, students dug deeper into understanding that the God (Elohim/Yaweh) of Genesis and The Bible is relational, undisputed, unchallenged, matchless and bigger than we can fully understand. They also investigated the historical, cultural and geographical context of Genesis and the reliability of Bible, along with contemporary views on creation and our roles as Christians in the sciences and environmental care. Then they looked at complex biological and chemical systems in our world and gained a greater appreciation for the God who made it all.
